Rating Rationale

Acuité has downgraded the long-term rating to 'ACUITE B+' (read as ACUITE B plus) from 'ACUITE BB-' (read as ACUITE double B minus) and the short term rating of 'ACUITE A4' (read as ACUITE A four)' from 'ACUITE A4+' (read as ACUITE A four plus)' on the Rs. 11.50 crore bank facilities of Nanu Industries (NI). The rating continues to be flagged as "Issuer Not-Cooperating" and is downgraded on account of information risk.

About the Company

The Goa-based NI established in 1993 is a partnership firm promoted by Mr. Krishna Naik Mr. Pravas Naik Mr. Narayan Naik and others. The firm is engaged in the manufacture and crushing of sand aggregates and electric control panels. While the sand crushing units are located at Parme Maharashtra and Conquirem Goa, the control panels are manufactured at Ponda. The firm has an installed capacity of 1200 control panels per annum.

Non-cooperation by the issuer/borrower:

Acuité has been requesting for data, information and undertakings from the rated entity for conducting surveillance & review of the rating. However, the issuer/borrower failed to submit such information before the due date. Acuité believes that information risk is a critical component in such ratings, and non-cooperation by the issuer along with unwillingness to provide information could be a sign of potential deterioration in its overall credit quality. This rating is, therefore, being flagged as "Issuer not-cooperating", in line with prevailing SEBI regulations and Acuité's policies.

The rating is based on information available from sources other than the issuer/borrower (in the absence of information provided by the issuer/borrower). Acuité endeavored to gather information about the entity/industry from the public domain.
