Acuité has downgraded the long term rating to '**ACUITE BB-**' (read as **ACUITE double B minus**) from '**ACUITE BB**' (read as **ACUITE double B**) for Rs.16.00 crore facility of Kaveri Ginning Mills Private Limited (KGPL). The rating is now indicative and based on the best information available and is downgraded on account of information risk.

KGPL, based at Andhra Pradesh was incorporated in 2008 by Mr. K. Ramesh, Mrs. K. Sujana and others. The company is engaged in cotton ginning and oil extraction.

Non-cooperation by the issuer/borrower

Acuité has been requesting for data, information and undertakings from the rated entity for conducting surveillance & review of the rating. However, the issuer / borrower failed to submit such information before due date.

Acuité believes that information risk is a critical component in such ratings, and non-cooperation by the issuer along with unwillingness to provide information could be a sign of potential deterioration in its overall credit quality.
