The company is promoted by Mr. K. Srinivasan, has experience of around 15 years in the industry.

KPVPL reported profit after tax (PAT) of Rs.0.16 crore on operating income of Rs.8.98 crore for FY2013-14, as compared with PAT of Rs.0.32 crore on operating income of Rs.13.73 crore in FY2012-13. The company's net worth stood at Rs.6.58 crore as on March 31, 2014, as compared with Rs.6.33 crore a year earlier.
