Rating Rationale

Acuité has reaffirmed the long term rating of 'ACUITE B+' (read as ACUITE B plus) and the short term rating to 'ACUITE A4' (read as ACUITE A four) on the Rs.65.00 Cr. bank facilities of Abhilasha Jewellers Private Limited (AJPL). The rating continous to be flagged as "Issuer NotCooperating" and is based on the best available information.

Chennai-based Abhilasha Jewellers Private Limited (AJPL) was incorporated in 2003 by Mr. Prakash Chand Jain and Mr. Abhilash Kumar Mutha. The company is engaged in the manufacturing and wholesale of gold, silver and diamond jewellery in domestic and export markets. Further, AJPL also undertakes job work for Tanishq and Reliance.

Non-cooperation by the issuer/borrower:

Acuité has been requesting for data, information and undertakings from the rated entity for conducting surveillance & review of the rating. However, the issuer/borrower failed to submit such information before the due date.
