Rating Rationale

Acuite has downgraded the long-term rating to '**ACUITE B-**' (read as **ACUITE B minus**) from '**ACUITE B**' (read as **ACUITE B**) and reaffirmed the short-term rating of '**ACUITE A4**' (read as **ACUITE A four**) on the Rs. 20.00 crore bank facilities of Kuber Foods (KF) on account of information risk. The rating continues to be flagged as "Issuer Not-Cooperating" and is based on the best available information.

About the Company

Haryana based, Kuber Foods is a partnership firm established by Mr. Rajeev Kumar and Mr. Anil Kumar in 2002. The firm is engaged in the business of milling of paddy, processing and selling of Basmati Rice and its by-products viz husk, bran and broken rice. The manufacturing facility is located at Taraori in Karnal (Haryana) with an installed capacity of 1.50 tons per hour.

Non-cooperation by the issuer/borrower:

Acuite has been requesting for data, information and undertakings from the rated entity for conducting surveillance & review of the rating. However, the issuer/borrower failed to submit such information before the due date. Acuite believes that information risk is a critical component in such ratings, and non-cooperation by the issuer along with unwillingness to provide information could be a sign of potential deterioration in its overall credit quality. This rating is, therefore, being flagged as "Issuer not-cooperating", in line with prevailing SEBI regulations and Acuite's policies.

Limitation regarding information availability

This rating is based on information available from sources other than the issuer / borrower (in the absence of information provided by the issuer / borrower) . Acuite endeavoured to gather information about the entity/industry from the public domain. Any rating with the suffix

'Issuer not cooperating' is assigned without any management interaction with the issuer entity

or any data / information from the entity. Sometimes this non co-operation by a rated entity may be due to a result of deterioration in the credit risk profile of the entity.
