The Kolkata-based Alpine Distilleries Private Limited (ADPL), the erstwhile Agnes Impex Private Limited was established in 2002 and commenced commercial operations in 2012. The company was promoted by Mr. Debraj Mukherjee Balbir Singh Malhotra and Mr. Debasis Mukherjee (Directors). It is engaged in the manufacture of Indian Made Foreign Liquor (IMFL) and country spirit at Hooghly, West Bengal. The installed capacity stands at 175000 and 200000 cases per month for IMFL and country

spirit respectively. The company undertakes bottling for reputed brands such as Officers Choice and Old Monk.
