SMERA has assigned rating of '**SMERA D**' (read as **SMERA D**) to the above mentioned bank facilities of Baba Jatadhari Agro (India) Private Limited (Baba Jatadhari Agro). The rating reflects delays in servicing of debt obligations due to the weak liquidity position of the company. The rating is also constrained by the limited track record and relatively small scale of operations. However, the aforementioned weaknesses are partially offset by an experienced management.
