## Rating Rationale

Acuite has reaffirmed the long-term rating of 'ACUITE B' (read as ACUITE B) on the Rs. 14.00 crore bank facilities of Acore Industries Private Limited (AIPL). The rating continues to be flagged as "Issuer Not Cooperating" and is based on the best available information.

## About the Company

Mumbai based, Acore Industries Private Limited (AIPL) was incorporated in the year 2015 by Mrs. Shaila Melligeri and Mrs. Anasuya Melligeri. The company is primarily to take over the land and machines of M/s. Jayaalaxmi Mineral Private Limited (JMPL). The company proposes to commence the process of Beneficiation of iron ore and manganese ore for companies engaged in mining. Apart from beneficiation of iron ore purchased by the company, it would also engage in undertaking beneficiation on job-work basis.

## Non-cooperation by the issuer/borrower:

Acuite has been requesting for data, information and undertakings from the rated entity for conducting surveillance & review of the rating. However, the issuer/borrower failed to submit such information before the due date. Acuite believes that information risk is a critical component in such ratings, and non-cooperation by the issuer along with unwillingness to provide information could be a sign of potential deterioration in its overall credit quality. This rating is, therefore, being flagged as "Issuer not-cooperating", in line with prevailing SEBI regulations and Acuite's policies.

## Limitation regarding information availability:

The rating is based on information available from sources other than the issuer/borrower (in the absence of information provided by the issuer/borrower). Acuite endeavored to gather information about the entity/industry from the public domain. Therefore, Acuite cautions lenders and investors regarding the use of such information, on which the indicative credit rating is based.
