Rating Rationale

Acuité has withdrawn the long term rating of '**ACUITE B+**' (read as **ACUITE B plus**) on the Rs.10.00 Cr. bank facilities of R. R. Business Private Limited (RRBPL). The rating continuous to be flagged as an 'Issuer Not-Cooperating' based on best available information.

The rating is being withdrawn on account of the request received from the company and the NDC received from the banker as per Acuité's policy on withdrawal of ratings.

About the Entity

RRBPL, incorporated in 2007, is a Nagpur-based company promoted by Mr. Ramprasad Agrawal, who has experience of more than three decades in the coal trading and distribution industry. The company is engaged in the trading of coal.

Non-cooperation by the issuer/borrower

Acuité has been requesting for data, information and undertakings from the rated entity for conducting surveillance & review of the rating. However, the issuer / borrower failed to submit such information before the due date.

Acuité believes that information risk is a critical component in such ratings, and non-cooperation by the issuer along with an unwillingness to provide information could be a sign of potential deterioration in its overall credit quality.
