Rating Rationale

Acuité has reaffirmed the long-term rating of '**ACUITE B+**' (read as **ACUITE single B plus**) the short term rating of '**ACUITE A4**' (read as **ACUITE A four**) on the Rs. 59.80 crore bank facilities of R P Edible Oils Private Limited (RPEOPL). The rating continues to be flagged as "Issuer Not-Cooperating" and is based on best available information.

About the Company

The Delhi-based R P Edible Oils Private Limited (RPEOPL) was incorporated in 1996 by Mr. B M Agarwal, Mr. Ajay Agarwal, Mr. K.C Agarwal and Rakesh Agarwal. The company is engaged in filtering, packing and trading of Edible Oils like Mustard Oil, Refined Oil & Blended Edible Vegetable Oils. The company is selling products under two marketing channels, i.e. bulk sale and retail sale.

Non-cooperation by the issuer/borrower:

Acuité has been requesting for data, information and undertakings from the rated entity for conducting surveillance & review of the rating. However, the issuer/borrower failed to submit such information before the due date. Acuité believes that information risk is a critical component in such ratings, and non-cooperation by the issuer along with unwillingness to provide information could be a sign of potential deterioration in its overall credit quality. This rating is, therefore, being flagged as "Issuer not-cooperating", in line with prevailing SEBI regulations and Acuité's policies.

Limitation regarding information availability:

The rating is based on information available from sources other than the issuer/borrower (in the absence of information provided by the issuer/borrower). Acuité endeavored to gather information about the entity/industry from the public domain. Therefore, Acuité cautions lenders and investors regarding the use of such information, on which the indicative credit ratings is based.
