Rating Rationale

Acuite has reaffirmed the long-term rating of '**ACUITE B**' (read as **ACUITE B**) and short-term rating of '**ACUITE A4**' (read as **ACUITE A Four**) on the Rs. 8.00 crore bank facilities of Monarch Self Adhesive Tapes and Foams India Private Limited (Monarch). The rating continues to be flagged as "Issuer Not-Cooperating" and is based on the best available information.

About the Company

Monarch Self Adhesive Tapes and Foams India Private Limited a Bangalore based company was originally started in 1978. Later in December 1993, the company got converted into a private limited company and was named as Monarch Self Adhesive Tapes and Foams India Private Limited. The company was promoted by Mr. Prabhakar N Metrani. Monarch is engaged in manufacturing of various types of adhesive tapes for the diverse customer base across multiple end markets. The founder and promoter of the company, Mr. Prabhakar N Metrani is one of the pioneers in self-adhesive tapes and was associated earlier with a multinational company, J&J in Q.A and R&D. He has to his credit of introducing many new tapes for the first time in India. He is the first to introduce PVC Insulation Tapes conforming to defence specifications, polyethylene self-adhesive tapes for pipe wrapping of underground pipes in petrol refinery and Cloth gummed tape for packaging before BOPP Tape came into Indian Market.
