Acuite has downgraded the long term rating to '**ACUITE BB-**' (read as **ACUITE double B minus**) from '**ACUITE BB**' (read as **ACUITE BB**) on the Rs.29.70 crore bank facilities of V. P. Muthaiah Pillai Meenakshi Ammal Trust (VPMP). The rating continues to be flagged as "Issuer Not-Cooperating" and is downgraded on account of information risk.

VPMP was established in 1993 by Dr. V.P.M. Sankar (Chairman) and others. The trust has eight institutions with over 6000 students in the campus spread across 200 acres. The day-to-day operations are managed by the Chairman of the trust.

Non-cooperation by the issuer/borrower:

Acuite has been requesting for data, information and undertakings from the rated entity for conducting surveillance & review of the rating. However, the issuer/borrower failed to submit such information before the due date.

This rating continues to be flagged as "Issuer not-cooperating", in line with prevailing SEBI regulations and Acuite's policies.
