Rating Downgraded, Reaffirmed and Issuer not co-operating

Rating Rationale

Acuité has downgraded the long-term rating to 'ACUITE B' (read as ACUITE B) from 'ACUITE B+' (read as ACUITE B plus) and reaffirmed the short-term rating of 'ACUITE A4' (read as ACUITE A four) on the Rs. 69.68 crore bank facilities of Komos Automotive India Private Limited (KAIPL) on account of information risk. The rating continues to be flagged as "Issuer Not-Cooperating" and is based on the best available information.

About the Company

Komos Automotive India Private Limited (KAIPL), incorporated in 2006, is a wholly-owned subsidiary of Komos company limited. KAIPL is a Tier-I supplier for Hyundai Motors India Limited (HMIL), engaged in manufacturing of steering wheels, horn covers, consoles and trim, pillar parts and clutch assembly for i10, i20, EON, Verna, Elantra models of HMIL. The current directors of the company are Mr Jongick Lee and Mr Sang Je Cho. The company has its registered office located at Chennai.
