Rating Rationale

ACUITE has reviewed long-term rating of '**ACUITE B**' (**read as ACUITE B**) on the Rs 5.00 crore bank facilities of Huns Digital Homes Private Limited. This rating is now an indicative rating and is based on best available information.

Non-cooperation by the issuer/borrower

Acuite has been requesting for data, information and undertakings from the rated entity for conducting surveillance & review of the rating. However, the issuer / borrower failed to submit such information before due date.

This rating is therefore being flagged as "Issuer not-cooperating", in line with prevailing SEBI regulations and Acuite's policies.

About the Rated Entity

The Maharashtra-based Huns Digital Homes Private Limited (HDHPL) was incorporated in 2002 by Mr. Pravin Ranka, Mr. Mahendra Ranka & Mr. Ashok Ranka. The company is a distributor of Panasonic and Philips home appliances such as LED TV's, Air Condition, Refrigerators, Washing Machines, etc. HDHPL is also engaged in trading of electronic products and home appliances for other brands in Pune location.

For FY2015-16, HDHPL reported profit after tax (PAT) of Rs.0.10 crore on total operating income of Rs.18.50 crore as compared with PAT of Rs.0.08 crore on total operating income of Rs.19.95 crore in FY2014-15. The tangible net worth stood at Rs.1.76 crore as on March 31, 2016 as compared to Rs.1.66 crore as on March 31, 2015.
