#### Rating Rationale

Acuité has downgraded the long-term rating to 'ACUITE B+' (read as ACUITE B plus) from 'ACUITE BB-' (read as ACUITE double B minus) and the short term rating to 'ACUITE A4' (read as ACUITE A four) from 'ACUITE A4+' (read as ACUITE A four plus) on the Rs.10.00 crore bank facilities of B Ghose And CO Private Limited (BGPL) on account of information risk. The rating continues to be flagged as "Issuer Not-Cooperating" and is based on the best available information.

#### **About the Company**

B Ghose And CO Private Limited (BGPL) was established in 1956 as a proprietorship firm, which was later reconstituted as a private limited company in 1970. B Ghose And CO Private Limited (BGPL) is primarily engaged in stevedoring activities apart from being one of the largest handler of breakbulk cargo. The operations are mainly confined to Kolkata port with minor activities in Haldia port. Currently, the business is managed by Mr. Sharad Varma and Mrs. Mallika Varma.
