Rating Rationale

Acuite has reaffirmed the long-term rating of ‘**ACUITE D**’ (read as **ACUITE D**) and short-term rating of ‘**ACUITE D**’ (read as **ACUITE D**) on the Rs. 35.00 crore bank facilities of Excellous Commodities Private Limited (ECPL). The rating continues to be flagged as “Issuer Not Cooperating” and is based on the best available information.

About the Company

Excellous Commodities Private Limited (ECPL) is a Mumbai-based company incorporated in 2013. The company, promoted by Mr. Alkesh Ramwani, is engaged in trading of commodities (sugar, food grains, fabrics, crowbar and bitumen) for government agencies in Karnataka, Andhra Pradesh and Maharashtra. Further, the company is also engaged in the manufacturing of readymade garments at Bhiwandi with total installed capacity of 20,000 pieces per month. ECPL exports its products to Dubai, Hong Kong and United States.

Non-cooperation by the issuer/borrower:

Acuite has been requesting for data, information and undertakings from the rated entity for conducting surveillance & review of the rating. However, the issuer/borrower failed to submit such information before the due date. Acuite believes that information risk is a critical component in such ratings, and non-cooperation by the issuer along with unwillingness to provide information could be a sign of potential deterioration in its overall credit quality.

This rating is, therefore, being flagged as “Issuer not-cooperating”, in line with prevailing SEBI regulations and Acuite’s policies.
