Rating Rationale

Acuite has withdrawn the long term rating of '**ACUITE BB-**' (read as **ACUITE double B minus**) on the Rs.5.28 Cr. bank facilities of Ghanshyam Impex (GI). The rating is now flagged as an 'Issuer Not-Cooperating' based on best available information.

The rating is being withdrawn on account of the request received from the company and the NOC received from the banker as per Acuite's policy on withdrawal of ratings.

About the Entity

Ghanshyam Impex (GI) was established in the year 2010, by Mr. Jivrajibhai Laxmanbhai Mavani, Mr. Himmatbhai Laxmanbhai Mavani, Mr. Ghanshyambhai Laxmanbhai Mavani and Mr. Jaysukhbhai Laxmanbhai Mavani. The firm is engaged in cutting and polishing of rough diamonds. The firm has a processing unit located in Surat.

Non-cooperation by the issuer/borrower

Acuite has been requesting for data, information and undertakings from the rated entity for conducting surveillance & review of the rating. However, the issuer / borrower failed to submit such information before the due date.

Acuite believes that information risk is a critical component in such ratings, and non-cooperation by the issuer along with an unwillingness to provide information could be a sign of potential deterioration in its overall credit quality.
