**Rating Rationale**

Acuite has reaffirmed the long-term rating to '**ACUITE D**' (read as **ACUITE D**) on the Rs.11.00 crore bank facilities of Mangal Siddhi Multipurpose Multistate Sahakari Sangh Limited. The rating continues to be flagged as "Issuer Not-Cooperating" and is based on the best available information.

**About the Company**

Pune based Mangal Siddhi Multipurpose Multistate Sahakari Sangh Limited is a Co-operative society established in 2005 with director Mr. Rajendra Tambile. The society is engaged in processing and distribution of milk to various brands such as Amul, Gokul, Mahanand, among others. The society also sells the milk and other related products such as butter, ghee, Lassi, Buttermilk under its own brand name 'Rajmangal'. The society has a milk handling capacity of around 1 lakh litres per day.

**Non-cooperation by the issuer/borrower:**

Acuite has been requesting for data, information and undertakings from the rated entity for conducting surveillance & review of the rating. However, the issuer/borrower failed to submit such information before the due date. Acuite believes that information risk is a critical component in such ratings, and non-cooperation by the issuer along with unwillingness to provide information could be a sign of potential deterioration in its overall credit quality. This rating is, therefore, being flagged as "Issuer not-cooperating", in line with prevailing SEBI regulations and Acuite's policies.
