Rating Rationale

Acuité has downgraded the long term rating to '**ACUITE BB-**' (**read as ACUITE double B minus**) from '**ACUITE BB**' (**read as ACUITE double B**) on the Rs.29.50 crore bank facilities of J D Sons Steels Private Limited (JDSSL). This rating is now an indicative rating and is downgraded on account of information risk.

Haryana-based, J D Sons Steel Private Limited was incorporated in the year 2001 by Mr. Darshan Goyal and Mr. Vinod Goyal. The company is primarily engaged in the manufacturing of cold-rolled carbon strips and coils, and mild steel wires. The key promoter, Mr. Goyal, has been in the iron and steel industry since 1971.

Non-cooperation by the issuer/borrower:

Acuité has been requesting for data, information and undertakings from the rated entity for conducting surveillance & review of the rating. However, the issuer/borrower failed to submit such information before the due date.

This rating is, therefore, being flagged as "Issuer not-cooperating", in line with prevailing SEBI regulations and Acuité's policies.

Acuité believes that information risk is a critical component in such ratings, and non-cooperation by the issuer along with an unwillingness to provide information could be a sign of potential deterioration in its overall credit quality.
