## Rating Rationale

Acuite has downgraded the long-term rating to '**ACUITE B+**' (read as **ACUITE B plus**) from '**ACUITE BB-**' (read as **ACUITE double B minus**) and the short term rating to '**ACUITE A4**' (read as **ACUITE A four**) from '**ACUITE A4+**' (read as **ACUITE A four plus**)' on the Rs. 15.00 crore bank facilities of Shree Parmeshwar Steels Private Limited (SPSPL). The rating continues to be flagged as "Issuer Not-Cooperating" and is downgraded on account of information risk.

## About the Company

Incorporated in 1998, SPSPL is a Gujarat-based company, promoted by Mr. Indravadan Patel. The company is engaged in manufacturing of thermo- mechanically treated (TMT) steel bars, and steel structural products with a capacity of one lakh metric tons per annum.

## Non-cooperation by the issuer/borrower:

Acuite has been requesting for data, information and undertakings from the rated entity for conducting surveillance & review of the rating. However, the issuer/borrower failed to submit such information before the due date. Acuite believes that information risk is a critical component in such ratings, and non-cooperation by the issuer along with unwillingness to provide information could be a sign of potential deterioration in its overall credit quality. This rating is, therefore, being flagged as "Issuer not-cooperating", in line with prevailing SEBI regulations and Acuite's policies.

The rating is based on information available from sources other than the issuer/borrower (in the absence of information provided by the issuer/borrower). Acuité endeavored to gather information about the entity/industry from the public domain.
