Rating Rationale

Acuite has downgraded its long-term rating to ‘**ACUITE BB-**’ (read as **ACUITE double B minus**) from ‘**ACUITE BB**’ (read as **ACUITE double B**) and the short-term rating to ‘**ACUITE A4**’ (read as **ACUITE A four**) from ‘**ACUITE A4+**’ (read as **ACUITE A four plus**) on Rs. 13.40 Cr. bank facilities of Jayachandran Industries Private Limited (JIPL.) The rating downgrade is on account of information risk. The rating is now flagged as “Issuer Not-Cooperating” on account of information risk and is based on the best available information.

About the Company

Incorporated in 2009 by Mr. Anbalagan and his four brothers, JIPL is engaged in manufacture of lead acid batteries for automobiles and invertor systems. The company markets the batteries under the brand name ‘JC’. The company has facility located in Coimbatore (Tamil Nadu) with installed capacity of 2400 MT per annum. The day to day operations of the company are managed by Mr. Bharani Kumar (Managing Director).

Non-cooperation by the issuer/borrower

Acuite has been requesting for data, information and undertakings from the rated entity for conducting surveillance & review of the rating. However, the issuer / borrower failed to submit such information before due date. Acuite believes that information risk is a critical component in such ratings, and non - cooperation by the issuer along with unwillingness to provide information could be a sign of potential deterioration in its overall credit quality. This rating is therefore being flagged as “Issuer not-cooperating”, in line with prevailing SEBI regulations and Acuite’s policies.

Limitation regarding information availability

This rating is based on information available from sources other than the issuer / borrower (in the absence of information provided by the issuer / borrower) . Acuite endeavoured to gather information about the entity/industry from the public domain. Any rating with the suffix ‘Issuer not cooperating’ is assigned without any management interaction with the issuer entity or any data / information from the entity. Sometimes this non co-operation by a rated entity may be due to a result of deterioration in the credit risk profile of the entity. Therefore, Acuite
