#### **Rating Rationale**

Acuité has downgraded the long-term rating to 'ACUITE B' (read as ACUITE B) from 'ACUITE B+' (read as ACUITE B plus) and reaffirmed the short-term rating of 'ACUITE A4' (read as ACUITE A four)' on the Rs. 6.00 crore bank facilities of Prashant Trading Co on account of information risk. The rating continues to be flagged as "Issuer Not-Cooperating" and is based on the best available information.

## **About the Company**

Prashant Trading Co is based at Mumbai, was established in 1974 by Mr. Dalichand Sanghvi and Mr. Vrajlal Sheth as a partnership firm. Since 1980, the firm is managed and controlled by Mr. Kirit Dalichand Sanghvi and Mr. Kamlesh Vrajlal Sheth. The firm is a trader of float glass and industrial chemicals, which it imports from Iran, China, Malaysia and sells in the domestic market. The firm also trades in cocoa butter, which it procures from Malaysia and sells in European countries.

#### Non-cooperation by the issuer/borrower:

Acuité has been requesting for data, information and undertakings from the rated entity for conducting surveillance & review of the rating. However, the issuer/borrower failed to submit such information before the due date.
