

# **Rating Rationale**

Acuité has downgraded the long-term rating to 'ACUITE B' (read as ACUITE B) from 'ACUITE B+' (read as ACUITE B plus) on the Rs. 50.00 crore bank facilities of Shree GRG Oil Mill on account of information risk. The rating continues to be flagged as "Issuer Not-Cooperating" and is based on the best available information.

# **About the Company**

Shree GRG Oil Mill is a Rajasthan based firm incorporated in 2004 by Mr. Satish Chandra Goyal and Mr. Saurabh Goyal. It is engaged in supplying and manufacturing of mustard oil, pure mustard oil, mustard cooking oil, kachi ghani mustard oil, refined mustard oil and mustard seed oils. It has an installed capacity to manufacture 100 tons of mustard oil per month and the utilisation level is 85-90 per cent.

#### **Unsupported Rating**

#### Non-cooperation by the issuer/borrower:

Acuité has been requesting for data, information and undertakings from the rated entity for conducting surveillance & review of the rating. However, the issuer/borrower failed to submit such information before the due date.
