### **Rating Rationale**

Acuité has downgraded the long-term rating to 'ACUITE B' (read as ACUITE B) from 'ACUITE B+' (read as ACUITE B plus) on the Rs.13.85 crore bank facilities of Supershine ABS Platers Private Limited (SAPPL) on account of information risk. The rating continues to be flagged as "Issuer Not-Cooperating" and is based on the best available information.

## About the Company

Mumbai based, Supershine ABS Platers Private Limited (SAPPL) was incorporated in 2004 by Mr. Suresh M. Shah. The company is engaged in surface finishing on various ABS (Acrylonitrile Butadiene Styrene) plastics and metals including electroplating of various pen parts, automobile parts and household articles. Further, the company has recently started manufacturing of metal parts and electroplating on them. It has been providing decorative metal finishing and electroplating services to a variety of products in a number of industries.

### **Unsupported Rating**

#### Non-cooperation by the issuer/borrower:
