Rating Rationale

ACUITE has reaffirmed the long term rating of 'ACUITE C' (read as ACUITE C) and the short term rating of 'ACUITE A4' (read as ACUITE A four) to the Rs. 84.00 Crore bank facilities of Krushi Infras India Private Limited. The rating continues to be flagged as "Issuer Not-Cooperating" and is based on the best available information.

About the Company

Hyderabad based Krushi Infras India Private Limited was established in 2008 by Mr. Ch. Krishna Reddy, engaged in utility and infrastructural projects like Water & Waste Management, buildings, irrigation projects and roads & bridges to name a few. The company is a registered special class contractor of Irrigation Department Govt. of Telangana and class 1 contractor with Karnataka State Public Works Department, Irrigation department and BUIDCO of Government of Bihar. The company has completed more than 1000 kms of sewer lines and Road works each.
