Rating Rationale

Acuite has reaffirmed and withdrawn the long-term rating of '**ACUITE B+**' (read as **ACUITE B plus**) on the Rs. 29.20 crore bank facilities of Durlax Top Surface Limited (Erstwhile Durlax Architech Private Limited)

. The rating continues to be flagged as "Issuer NotCooperating" and is based on the best available information. The rating has been withdrawn on Acuite's policy of withdrawal of ratings. The rating has been withdrawn on account of the request received from the company, and the NOC(No Objection Certificate) received from the banker.

About the Company

DAPL, incorporated in 2010, is a Mumbai-based company promoted by Mr. Shravan Suthar, Mr. Amit Vyas, Mr. Laxmichand L. Suthar that trades in decorative solid sheets and adhesives used in seamless countertop installations in the kitchen, exterior building façades, wall cladding among others.

Non-cooperation by the issuer/borrower:

Acuite has been requesting for data, information and undertakings from the rated entity for conducting surveillance & review of the rating. However, the issuer/borrower failed to submit such information before the due date.
