**Rating Rationale**

Acuite has downgraded the long-term rating to '**ACUITE D**' (read as **ACUITE D**) from '**ACUITE B+**' (read as **ACUITE B plus**) and short-term rating to '**ACUITE D**' (read as **ACUITE D**) from '**ACUITE A4**' (read as **ACUITE A Four**) on the Rs.15.50 Cr. bank facilities of Gemus Engineering Limited (GEL). The rating continues to be flagged as "Issuer Not Cooperating" and is based on the best available information.

The downgrade is on account of initiation of corporate insolvency resolution process against GEL as per latest NCLT order and other publicly available information.

**About the Company**

Gemus Engineering Limited (GEL) was established in 1996 and started operating since 2001. The company is engaged in manufacturing of customized ductile iron products with the installed capacity of 7000 MTPA per annum. The company is based in Kolkata (West Bengal) and is currently managed by Mr. Shyam Bihari Sharma, Mr. Om Prakash Choudhary and Mr. Mahesh Chowdhury.

**Non-cooperation by the issuer/borrower**

Acuite has been requesting for data, information and undertakings from the rated entity for conducting surveillance & review of the rating. However, the issuer/borrower failed to submit such information before the due date. Acuite believes that information risk is a critical component in such ratings, and noncooperation by the issuer along with unwillingness to provide information could be a sign of potential deterioration in its overall credit quality. This rating is, therefore, being flagged as "Issuer not-cooperating", in line with prevailing SEBI regulations and Acuite's policies
