#### **Rating Rationale**

Acuité has downgraded the long term rating to 'ACUITE B-' (read as ACUITE B minus) from 'ACUITE B' (read as ACUITE B) and reaffirmed the short term rating of 'ACUITE A4' (read as ACUITE A four) on the Rs. 17.00 crore bank facilities of Earth Stone Global on account of information risk. The rating continues to be flagged as "Issuer Not-Cooperating" and is based on the best available information.

### **About the Company**

Jaipur based, Earth Stone Global was established as a proprietorship concern in 2010 by Mr.Vikas Kanchhalat. The firm is engaged in the processing of natural stone and manufacturing of thin slate veneer tiles (Sand Stone, Slate Stone, among others) and mosaic tiles for the domestic and export market.

#### **Unsupported Rating**

#### Non-cooperation by the issuer/borrower:

Acuité has been requesting for data, information and undertakings from the rated entity for conducting surveillance & review of the rating. However, the issuer/borrower failed to submit such information before the due date. Acuité believes that information risk is a critical component in such ratings, and non-cooperation by the issuer along with unwillingness to provide information could be a sign of potential deterioration in its overall credit quality. This rating is, therefore, being flagged as "Issuer not-cooperating", in line with prevailing SEBI regulations and Acuité's policies.
