Rating Rationale

Acuité has reaffirmed the long-term rating of 'ACUITE B-' (read as ACUITE B minus) and short-term rating of 'ACUITE A4' (read as ACUITE A four) on the Rs. 6.50 crore bank facilities of Patel Filters Infrastructure. The rating continues to be flagged as "Issuer Not-Cooperating" and is based on the best available information.
