SMERA has reviewed the long term rating of '**SMERA BB-**' (read as SMERA double B minus) and short term rating of '**SMERA A4+**'(read as SMERA A four plus) on the Rs.25.00 crore on the bank facilities of Malhotra Electronics Private Limited. This rating is now an indicative rating and is based on best available information.

MEPL, incorporated in 1986, is a Noida based company promoted by Mr. Ravinder Singh Malhotra. The company is engaged in the manufacturing of electronic goods such as LED televisions apart from cabinets and CTV chassis and has an installed capacity of 650000 metric tons per annum.

For FY2015-16 (Provisional), MEPL reported profit after tax (PAT) of Rs. 0.89 crore on operating income of Rs. 99.51 crore, as compared with PAT of Rs. 0.76 crore on operating income of Rs. 87.85 crore in FY2014-15.
