The rating also reflects the firm's weak financial risk profile, working capital-intensive operations and modest scale of operations.

AE, established in 2005, is a Mumbai based partnership firm promoted by Mr. Avinash Virkar, Mr. Ankur Agarwal and Mr. Pawan Agarwal. AE is engaged in providing crane hiring services. The firm's cranes have lifting capacities of 40 metric tonnes (MT), 75 MT, 80 MT and 150 MT.

For FY2012-13 (refers to financial year, April 01 to March 31), AE reported profit after tax (PAT) of Rs.1.68 crore on operating income of Rs.3.77 crore, as compared with PAT of Rs.0.32 crore on operating income of Rs.3.03 crore in FY2011-12.
